Enhancements

Following are enhancements to existing features that we're releasing with version 1.9.1:

1 - Aliases

Coro now detects and links all *aliases* (O365, Google) to the relevant protected user account to ensure the user is always protected regardless of the number of *aliases* associated with them.

Additionally, all *aliases* (O365, Google) can be viewed in the **Protected users** widget under the **Emails** header, as well as in the **Control Panel > Protected Users** (expand the **Aliases** list under each email address).
